

Solano County Project Across Club Agreement Form

4-H members may participate in projects offered by a neighboring club, if the primary club does not offer the 4-H project a member is interested in or if the project offered by the primary club is full. The community 4-H club and project adult volunteers in both clubs and 4-H Youth Development Program (YDP) staff must approve the participation.

The completed request/agreement form must be returned to the 4-H staff for verification and approval.

This agreement requires that the 4-H member and member's parent/guardian, 4-H adult volunteers and staff agree to the following:

1. 4-H YDP staff reserve the right to reassess all previously granted approvals for membership allowing project across club lines when the 4-H program year begins, July 1.
2. Acknowledgement of the reasons for the cross club project participation.
3. The 4-H member agrees to follow the constitution and bylaws of the host 4-H club as it pertains to project completion and participation.
4. The 4-H member agrees to meet the requirements for participation and completion of the host club project.
5. Project records will be checked and signed by the host 4-H club project leader.
6. Transportation to the project meetings and activities is the responsibility of the member and their parent/guardian.
