Eligibility:

3. Plan to continue your education at a college, trade, or technical school.

Requirements:

1. Official copy of your high school transcript
2. One letter of recommendation from either an FFA advisor or a 4-H leader
3. **HANDWRITTEN** (not typed) letter of intent (250-500 work essay) that includes the following:
 - a) Short biography about yourself
 - b) Your immediate and long-term goals (education, career, and personal)
 - c) Financial need, if any
 - d) Answer the following prompt:

Our daughter, Margery, was inspired by many experiences during her short life, both at home and abroad. Describe an experience in your life that has built character in you, that has influenced your values and beliefs, and might have even aided in your current decision making process.
