gardens, moist and disturbed sites


Life Cycle Perennial

Flowering Time Mid-July to fall


Management Aggressive; pulling and burning favor root resprouting; use chemical control

for several years

Noxious Weed List Nevada-YES; California-YES, B-rated







- Leaves: smooth and sessile
- Flowers: multiple small flower heads in clusters on each stem
- Flower color: light purple to white
