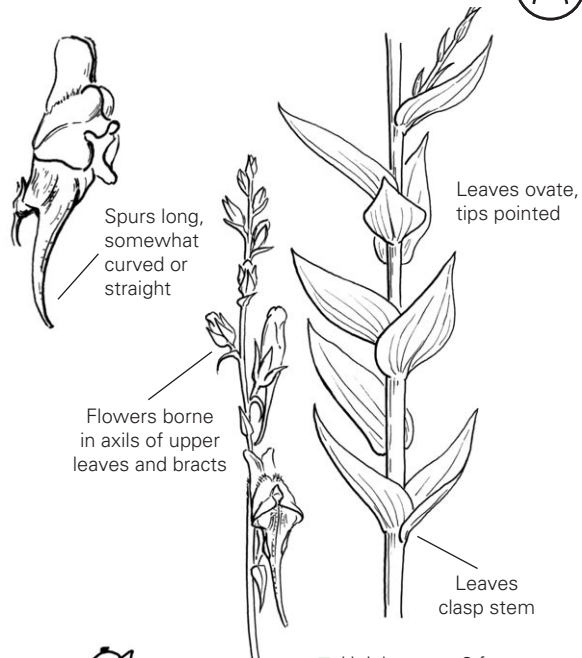




Donaldson

- Also Known As** Wild snapdragon
- Origin** Nonnative, invasive
- Habitat** Roadsides, pastures, rangelands, cultivated fields
- Life Cycle** Perennial
- Flowering Time** July to fall
- Management** Pull or dig for several years, removing as much root as possible; do not mow; chemical control is available
- Noxious Weed List** Nevada-YES; California-YES, A-rated

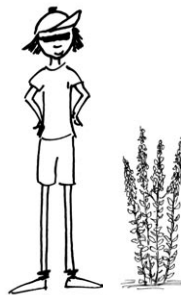


Spurs long, somewhat curved or straight

Flowers borne in axils of upper leaves and bracts

Leaves ovate, tips pointed

Leaves clasp stem



- Height: up to 3 ft
- Stems: erect and branched
- Leaves: ovate, alternate and entire; succulent and waxy
- Growth form: more scattered than yellow toadflax
- Flower color: yellow, with orange, bearded throat
