




The large 12- 16 oz., slightly flattened tomato has the wetness of a melon and can give a deep flavor explosion—fruity sweet and slightly spicy taste. EARLY GIRL 	60 Days Indeterminate Hybrid	Our earliest slicing tomato. Early Girl is a name gardeners have relied on for many years. These smooth red-skinned, meaty 4 to 6 oz. fruits are ready in just 60 days. Plants are vary heavy-bearing and vigorous with great disease resistance.	4

Has a mild flavor that is less acidic than many other varieties. Its vines are uniform and upright, making Golden Jubilee one of the easier varieties to manage. Excellent for making tomato juice and canning. Also good in salads and cooking.	4
ITALIAN GOLIATH 	76 Days Indeterminate Med. to Large Salad	Adds robust tomato flavor to all your favorite dishes. Firm, 8 oz. beefsteak type fruits, with excellent flavor turn from apple green with green shoulders to bright red at maturity. Vigorous plants, with good leaf cover, are strongly disease resistant.	4
JULIET 	60 Days Indeterminate Cherry/Salad	This 1999 AAS Winner is a large, pink-fruited cherry that will change the minds of those who feel that most cherry tomatoes lack flavor. Good acid content and exceptionally sweet flavor in meaty fruits that are produced in clusters. You can expect 9 to 14 fruits per cluster weighing about 1-1/2 oz. piece, with a distinct elongated shape. Resists cracking.	4

It produces short, bushy regular-leaf tomato plants that yield early bearing 14-16 ounce fruit. The uniform 4-5 inch smooth, round, blemish free, glossy red tomatoes have wonderfully delicious sweet flavors that are balanced well with just the right amount of acidity. Fruit has very few seeds. MARVEL STRIPE 	85 Days Indeterminate Large	This heirloom variety has become one of gardeners' favorite bicolored tomatoes because of its beauty, size, and taste. Large yellow-orange fruits are streaked with ruby red and have a sweet, fruity taste that is absolutely delicious. Tomatoes weigh about 1 lb., although they often become 2 lbs. or even more. Large harvests on vigorous vines.	5
MATINA 	67 Days Indeterminate Medium Salad	Plant produces good yields of 2 to 4 oz. red tomatoes. The taste is so good it would normally only be found in huge beefsteak varieties. A very early producing variety that bears continuously throughout the season. Excellent for salads and sandwiches. This is a potato leaf strain. An heirloom variety from Germany.	4
PRINCIPE BORGHESE 	75 Days Determinant Small Plum	Italian heirloom variety very popular in Italy and California for splitting in half and sun drying. Small plum to grape sized 1 to 2 oz fruit and very meaty. An ideal variety for drying with low moisture and few seeds. Although determinate, it will require some staking to support the vines heavy clusters of fruit. They maintain color and flavor well.	4

OREGON SPRING 	60 days Indeterminate	O.S. produces incredibly early yields of 4-inch oval tomatoes when planted early. Good for cooler temperatures. Plant produces heavy yields of 5 oz red tomatoes. Tomatoes are very flavor, meaty and have very few seeds. Excellent for making ketchup and sauce. Does well in cool weather too. Suitable for short season regions.	5
Radiator Charlie's Mortgage Lifter 	80 Days Indeterminate Large Heirloom	This huge heirloom beefsteak averaging 2 1/2 pounds consistently wins taste-tests. Mild, sweet flavor with pink skin. Developed in the 1930's by a gardener who planted the four biggest varieties he knew, and crossed one with pollen from the other three. He did this for six seasons and created a variety that produced immense, tasty fruit. He sold the plants for \$1 apiece and paid off his mortgage in six years.	5
SAN MARZANO REDORTA 	78 Days Indeterminate Heirloom Paste	Named for a mountain, Pizzo Redorta in Bergamo, Italy this is a preferred Italian paste tomato. An 8 oz. plum shaped tomato with a better taste than its cousin, San Marzano. This 4 inch tomato is good enough to eat off the vine with the bonus of ending up with more tomato paste per plant.	4
SHADY LADY 	75 Days Determinant Large Hybrid	Well- known in California for being a top performer and a favorite in farmers' markets. Large, determinate vines with ample foliage provide excellent coverage for the fruit, preventing sunburn, hence the name Shady Lady. Round, globe-shaped red tomatoes range from medium to extra large, and have an excellent flavor.	4

<p>SOPHIE'S CHOICE</p> 	<p>55 Days Determinant Large Salad Heirloom</p>	<p>Heirloom from Edmonton, Canada. The best choice for an extra early tomato - highly productive, flavorful and large-fruited averaging 6 to 8 oz. and has an orange-red exterior and deep red interior. Produces large fruit on a small plant only 18 to 24" tall. Quality is best in cool climates. Does not handle heat or drought well.</p>	<p>5</p>
<p>STUPICE</p> 	<p>52 days Indeterminate Heirloom</p>	<p>This 1-2 oz. tomato ripens red and slightly oval. Its 2-inch fruit makes an excellent choice for salad and juicing. Consistently gets high marks for taste throughout the summer. This potato-leaf heirloom from the Czech Republic is a cold-tolerant tomato that won first place for its wonderful sweet/acid tomatoey flavor in a comparative tasting in the San Francisco area.</p>	<p>5</p>
<p>SUN GOLD</p> 	<p>Cherry 60 Days Indeterminate</p>	<p>One of the best varieties of cherry tomatoes. The Sungold ripens to a golden orange, with a very sweet flavor. Plant produces heavy yields of golden cherry tomatoes. One of the sweetest tasting cherry tomatoes on the market! This tomato is popular in all climates as it produces in warm and cold conditions. Fruit matures quickly, and crops heavily. A variety from England.</p>	<p>4</p>
<p>SUN SUGAR</p> 	<p>Cherry 60 Days Indeterminate</p>	<p>The ultimate in cherry tomatoes, this golden yellow beauty achieves a new level of sugar-sweetness and flavor, superb texture, and a tangy "true tomato" taste. Fruits are a lovely golden yellow, weigh 1/2 oz., and possess thin skins - remarkable, considering its wonderful crack resistance, even in heavy rains. Heavy early cropper. Plants stay a manageable size, and produce a heavy crop of 12 to 16 oz. ribbed beefsteak-shaped fruit with wonderful, old-fashioned tomato flavor. Some of their best attributes after their great flavor are earliness, productivity, outstanding plant vigor, and the ability to keep after harvest. Selection Tip: when choosing varieties, keep in mind that “determinates” ripen over 3-4 weeks on bushy vines that usually need no staking. “Indeterminate” vines continue to grow and produce fruit all season until frost. The large vines need support.
