Re-Appointment Deadline: December 31, 2021.

- Submit your 4-H adult volunteer re-application in 4hOnline.
 Login to your family profile at https://ca.4honline.com. Do not create a new duplicate account! Login to adult record and click "Enroll for 2021-2022." Enter all required information and submit. 4hOnline adult status will show as pending.
- 2. Complete required "2020-21 California 4-H Returning Volunteers Course" in eXtension.
 Go to https://campus.extension.org/enrol/index.php?id=2074. Log into your existing account and click "2021-22 California 4-H Returning Volunteers Course/Entrenamiento de Voluntarios que Regresan de California" and enter the code "Marin". Completion time 45 minutes. (*Note: Every individual must use their own unique email address. For technical support, please contact idevelopsupport@ucanr.edu).
- 3. Submit \$30 program enrollment fee to the UCCE Marin County 4-H Office.
 - **by Credit Card**: Credit card payments may be made online at http://ucanr.edu/marinpay; service fee will be added to the payment.
 - **by Check or Cash:** Please make payable to UC Regents and drop-off or mail to: UCCE 1682 Novato Boulevard, Suite 150-B, Novato, CA 94947 (no service fee charged for checks). Regular office hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00am to 12:00pm and 1:00pm to 4:00pm.
 - Request Fee Waiver: The 4-H Youth Development Program is open to participants, regardless of their ability to pay. To request a waiver or reduction of program enrollment fees, please submit your request in writing to the 4-H office.
- 3. **The application is reviewed by the county director.** If approved, notification will be sent from 4hOnline. If there are any limitations on the appointment, a subsequent letter will be sent. If not approved, a letter will be sent to you from the county director.

If your enrollment has not been submitted and approved before December 31, 2021, starting January 1, 2022 you are not authorized to conduct any 4-H meetings or activities, transport 4-H members, or perform other 4-H adult volunteer duties, until you have been re-appointed and approved.
