

4-H Youth Member Enrollment Process

Marin County 2023-2024 4-H Youth Member Enrollment Process

For 4-H Program Year: July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024

Youth are eligible to participate in 4-H if they meet the following criteria:

- Primary Member: Must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth who turn 9 on or after January 1, 2024 must participate as a primary member until the end of the program year.
- Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Members: Must be 9 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth may join if they are not 19 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth who turn 19 and who are already a 4-H member may continue capstone activities through December 31, 2024.
 - Submit 4-H youth member enrollment online in ZSuite at https://4h.zsuite.org/.
 - Enrolled in 4-H the past 5 years: Click Forgot Password? and complete process to reset account and select PIN. Login to Primary profile and click Enroll Member/Volunteer Now for the applicable member. Enter all required information and submit. The youth member enrollment status will show as PENDING APPROVAL.
 - New to 4-H or enrolled before 2018-2019: Click Sign Up and create a household. Click + Household member to add individuals to the household. Enter all required information and submit. The youth member enrollment status will show as PENDING APPROVAL.
 - 2. Enrollment fee will be waived for the first 250 youth enrollments.
 - a. Select Youth Projects using survey: at http://ucanr.edu/marinpay; fiscal contributions are welcomed.
 - 3. The application is reviewed by the 4-H Club Leader and the County 4-H Office. When approved, notification of your 4-H youth enrollment will be sent from ZSuite.
