2 Archeology Technicians

Under supervision, these positions will perform a variety of tasks with local partners in Modoc County, California. Archaeological technicians work as members of a crew under the leadership of an experienced technician or professional archaeologist. They assist with on-the-ground survey and site recording. They will gain skills with compasses, topographic maps, handheld GPS devices, tablets, and digital cameras, as well as site identification and recording methods. Technicians help find the boundaries of sites, identify cultural materials, and complete the recording forms. The ability to work in remote, harsh and rapidly changing environments, work in all types of weather conditions, traverse uneven terrain, and interact well with a variety of people is required. We are flexible with three to six month positions available with flexible starting about May 9, 2022.

Job Requirements and Preferences

- Experience or interest in archeology, anthropology, forestry, wildlife, botany, and/or rangeland management
- Experience outdoors collecting data or other work
- Experience using field guides or training manuals
- Experience with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Publisher)
- Excellent organizational skills, attention to detail, and listening to directions
- Ability to work productively and communicate as part of a team, as well as independently under general direction to accomplish team goals
- Ability to read, interpret and navigate using topographic maps in remote settings and collect coordinates with hand-held GPS units
- Valid, state-issued driver's license and clean driving record and experience operating 4WD vehicles and ATVs on paved and unpaved roads, often in narrow or rocky areas, minimum 18 years old

- Position is based on an approximately 40 hour week with irregular work hours and schedule
- Position ideal for recently graduated or current students, **we are willing to train candidates**
- Three to six month position options with flexible starting date after May 9, 2022
- This is an hourly paid internship (\$15-17 per hour, based on experience)
