In addition to the requirements listed for each project, all members enrolled in each project must maintain accurate records of project meetings and activities. All rules and qualifications listed here are project-specific.

All actions by members and leaders must comply with California 4-H regulations and Code of Conduct as well as items listed in the San Benancio 4-H Constitution and By Laws.

Meetings will be scheduled by leaders and can be held any time throughout the year. Projects must include a minimum of 3 meetings or at least 6 hours of meeting time. A minimum of 80% project attendance is required (100% preferred); make-up meetings and activities are at the Leader's discretion.
