It is the member’s responsibility to fill this form out and return it to the Club Leader on the announced due date. This form is posted on the club’s Shutterfly account.

### **Qualifications:**

1. Member is in good standing with the 4-H Club.
2. Member is graduating from high school.
3. Member has turned in all Annual Project Forms

### **Application to Include:**

1. The 4-H Senior Scholarship Application
2. Two paragraph essay on your 4-H experiences.

### **When are the Scholarships available?**

The San Benancio 4-H Senior Scholarship application form will be available on the Shutterfly website and by request from the Community Leader by May 1st. Applications are due to the Community Club Leader by the announced date. No late applications will be considered.

### **When are the Scholarships awarded?**

After applications have been accepted, the Community Leader/Scholarship Committee will review them. If the member has met the qualifications, the member/family will receive a club check by June 30<sup>th</sup> of 4-H year.
