



Monterey County 4-H Enrollment Fee Waiver Application

Dear Family,

Thank you for your interest in the Monterey County 4-H Program. The 4-H Program offers enrollment fee assistance to families that qualify for any or all of the following:

- Free or reduced lunch (not for clubs in school districts that serve entire student community without an approved application process)
WIC
SNAP Ed
Cal Fresh

Enrollment Assistance is available to cover the enrollment fees for youth members and adult volunteers interested in enrolling in 4-H. Fifty percent (50%) of the family fees will be paid by the Monterey County 4-H Council.

The remaining 50% will be determined between your family and the club you enroll in. Each 4-H club has established its own process for determining how the remaining 50% will be covered. Please speak with your Community Club Leader for the process being used in your community club.

(Note - the base fee for 2024-25 is \$67. This means clubs will be invoiced 37.50 for each member)

Families are reminded that enrollment fee waivers must be applied for annually, and cover the period from July 1st through June 30th annually.
