New! This 4-H Photography will have 4 categories: Animals, People, Scenic Historical places. Members must enter for the contest online using this link:

All photography must be on site to check in by 8:30am on 2/22. All entries must be picked up that day. Please follow this criteria:

All 4-H members aged 9-19 are allowed to participate.
Limit of 2 photographs per person may be entered.
MUST pre-register to participate in the competition.
Photographs must be taken by the person entering the contest.
Photographs must have been taken within the current 4-H year.
Photographs must be mounted on a photograph mount/mat board or foam board.
Maximum mount/mat board size is 11" x 14".
Photographs must be at least 8" x 10".
Framed photographs will NOT be accepted. A double mount board does not classify as
framed.
Covering photographs in a plastic protective is strongly discouraged.
Following information is required on back of entry: title of photograph, date and location
the photograph was taken, 4-H member's name, age, county, 4-H Club/Unit, and contact
information (email, phone, address).
Photos can be taken by either digital cameras, cell phones or by cameras using film.
Photographs may be either developed by the member or professionally developed.
Photographs can be printed via a photo printer with a high dpi or at a professional
printing service.
Digital enhancements to photographs are allowed.

Please bring entries plastic or paper bags for protection. The 4-H Photography Contest is hosted by the Spring 4-H club committee and is a part of the annual 4-H Fantastic Field Day sponsored by the 4-H Leaders Council.
