

# Post Fire Recovery Project



Severe wildfires in Ventura and LA Counties have damaged urban and rural roads, culverts, structures, and hill slopes, resulting in potential discharges of sediment, metals, nutrients, and other pollutants to adjacent streams, threatening aquatic life and public health.

This project, in partnership with Ventura RCD and Los Angeles Regional Water Board will implement erosion control Best Management Practices (BMPs) to **reduce erosion on private and public lands impacted by 2018, (INCLUDING THE THOMAS FIRE), 2019, and 2020 wildfires within Ventura County.**

**The Program will allocate a total of \$320,000 worth of reimbursable supplies across at least 16 sub-projects, funding will be available on a first come first serve basis.** Examples of BMP materials include, but are not limited to: silt fencing, jute netting, sandbags, Filtrexx Siltsoxx, native plantings, seeding, straw wattles, road and culvert replacement, and much more.

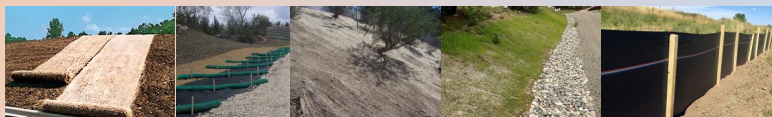
