

### **Virtual 4-H Disclaimer and Waiver**

This statement is to be used as a required element of registration for online/virtual 4-H programming:

Participation in California 4-H Youth Development Program (4-H YDP) online activities or projects carries with it certain inherent risks and some activities may require the supervision or assistance of a parent or guardian. These activities include, but not limited to cooking skills, livestock, outdoor skills, science experiments, etc. The specific hazards vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains, to 2) major injuries such as eye injury, joint or bone injuries, heart attacks, and concussions, to 3) catastrophic injuries such as paralysis and death. Participants and their parents/guardians are expected to adhere to any and all safety warnings or procedures provided in the lesson materials or by the 4-H YDP staff or volunteer(s) who are leading the online activity.

By registering my child for this 4-H YDP online activity I state that I will supervise my child during the activity and I hereby release, waive, discharge, and promise not to sue The Regents of the University of California, its directors, officers, employees, and agents ("The University"), from liability from any and all claims, including the negligence of the University, resulting in personal injury (including death), accidents or illnesses, and property loss, in connection with my (or my child's) participation in California 4-H YDP online activities and projects.
