

Ventura County 4-H Management Board

Travel Stipend Process



Background:

The Ventura County 4-H Management Board is eager to support out-of-county travel to attend conferences, camps, etc. for the enrichment of our county's 4-H program.

Program:

Members and leaders attending learning opportunities outside of Ventura County can apply for stipends in increments of \$100 for in-state travel and \$200 for out-of-state travel. Requests will be reviewed on a first-come, first-reviewed priority, **one stipend per person in each program year**, only if funds are available, and normally only when submitted prior to the date of travel.

Requests need to include:

- Name and club of the participant traveling
- Name, dates and location of the learning opportunity – estimates accepted
- Expected learning opportunity – why are you going?
- How you will enrich our County 4-H program with what you have learned. This could include but is not limited to presenting a workshop or other presentation at the county level, enhancing an existing program in some way, taking on additional responsibility at the county level, etc. This may be negotiated as part of the request process.
- Any additional information

In addition, before the stipend will be given:

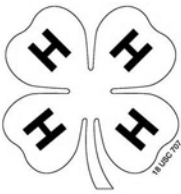
