Wyatt reported that he finished his All Star project teaching younger members about cavies. Wyatt went to the Lake County Board of Supervisors Meeting and finished his news article.

- **Review "notes" of August Council meeting** - *All financial matters must be voted upon during a full council meeting with a quorum present.
- Ethan Jones completed and shared his final project and it was approved by EC in July.

New/unfinished Business:

- **Proposal to merge the savings and checking accounts.** M/S Katy Evans/Christina B. Motion carried.

- **Motion to change signers of the account to include Shirley Morse, Peggy Alexander, Lisa Prather, Katheryn Blyleven, Karen Hayes, and Keith Wentworth.** M/S Lisa Illg/Jennifer C. Motion carried.
- **Approval of All Star designs for nametags and sweatshirt -** M/S: Ethan Jones/Wyatt Gaskel.
Discussion: Keith reported that the teens were looking for a new and updated design for their nametags and sweatshirts. Keith showed the design and reported that James Christianson will be producing them. The nametags will have the feature of changing/updating the title as needed. All Star sweatshirts/t-shirts will also include the UCCE branding logo on the bottom end of the sleeve. Motion carried.
- **Approval of Wyatt Gaskel's All Star project.** M/S Katy Evans/Chris Lynch. Discussion: Wyatt just needed one signature. Motion carried.
- **Approval of \$2000 from the County Wide Resources Fund to support the new Teen Ambassador Project –** M/S Christina Birge/Lisa Illg . Discussion: Peggy and Keith shared the focus of this new program to allow teens to look at ways to revitalize, reconnect, and keep clubs aware and involved in the changes coming. The goals and time commitment of this project are vague because the youth will actually be designing the scope and mission of this project. They will make time commitments and choose a name for their group at their first meeting. Motion carried.

Discussion:

- Veteran's Day – Nov 11 at 11a.m. at Konocti Vista Casino. Youth to show up in full uniform with cards to pass out. Come about 15 minutes early.
- Supporting our 4-H families impacted by the Lake County fires. (4-H attire, hats, cages, feed, animals, etc. are needed. Julie is creating a list of needs and families impacted. *Please call the 4-H office if you know of 4-H families that have been affected and have specific needs.) Julie handed out rosters for people to mark families affected by the fire for the 4-H families. Please send more names into the 4-H office as you become aware of them. Lake County Rising donated \$10,000 to FFA and 4-H. The money is to be used primarily for lost equipment/animals, etc. There was discussion about creating a long term category for the Lake County Fair Foundation to help offset costs of youth who suffer emergencies. There will be a new FFA/4-H Need's Committee forming. The Lake County Farm Bureau has a scholarship that can be used to help with replacing fencing/fencing supplies. We need names!
- Letter of Protest regarding Level I, II, III designation of awards at Record Book Competition. (Peggy reported that the state has made a new record book manual with a change for the awards from gold, blue, red replaced by Level I as the highest, Level II, and Level III being the lowest) Members present were invited to sign before Lisa P sends it off.

- Achievement Celebration –**new date! November 15th** 4:30-6:00 Kelseyville HS in the Student Activity Room (Blue Heron and Cole Creek to host)
- Donation of 4-H Blankets (Julie – 4-H club from Sonoma County made no sew fleece blankets and these were passed out to 4-H families. They were well received.)
- County Wide Presentation Day: Host: Scotts Valley/Joni Falkenberg . Presentation Day is tentatively scheduled for Feb. 27, 2016 to be held– Mountain Vista Middle School – pending arrangements.
- Fair Board – Katy Evans – reported that they are still wrapping up the old year. Thank you appreciation dinner. Spring Fair is being discussed to make changes or replace it. Next meeting will be in November, then the office will close for the Holiday's to reopen in Jan.)
- JLAC- Katy Evans – next meeting Nov 19th @ 6:30 at the Fair Grounds. They will elect new officers. Suggested changes in the fair book need to be turned in ASAP. They are working on changing bylaws and creating a budget.

Office Report: Julie

- Information about uniform changes- Fair Petition Letter is still being passed around for signatures.
- New dress code guidelines – Casual, Business Casual, Business – see the state website.
- Uniform guidelines – changes include getting rid of the white hat, the green hat is getting the new branding - will be available in December. You can keep your white hat until you age out of the program. The website has FAQ on the uniform with some of the reasons for modifications.
- Record Book Manual and Judging/Evaluating – New record book manual is out and the forms are online. Advantage to the online record book provides access at all times.
