Application Requirements

To apply for the training class for UCANR Fresno County Master Gardener's training class you must:

- Be at least 18 years old & reside in Fresno or Madera County
- Submit a class application and participate in the interview process.
- Be willing and able to share your gardening knowledge with others.

Volunteer Commitment:

The UC Master Gardener program's mission is to inform and educate the public about research based gardening practices. Being a UC Master Gardener requires a commitment to community service. Master Gardeners agree to participate in approved Master Gardener programs and continue their own education in horticulture.

To maintain active Master Gardener status, volunteers must complete:

- 50 hours of volunteer work on approved educational programs during the first year as a Master Gardener.
- 25 hours of volunteer work each year thereafter.
- 12 hours of continuing education each year.
