Bronze Star	HT	Bronze
Pope John Paul	HT	White, very fragrant
Double Delight	HT	White with deep rosy red edges, very hardy and fragrant
Hot Cocoa	FL	Deep red, with smoky black base, not as fragrant as some
St. Patrick's Day	HT	Light greenish yellow, can last 2 weeks in a vase
Firefighter	HT	Red, fragrant
Twilight Zone	GR	Smoky dark purple
Love Song	FL	Lavender, good substitute for Sterling Silver which is hard to grow in Napa
Valencia	HT	Light coppery peach center, creamy outside, fragrant, thick stemmed
Just Joey	HT	Peachy, fluffy
Paradise Found	HT	Lavender with magenta red edge
Yves Piaget	HT	Medium pink, fluffy, very fragrant

HT: Hybrid tea      Lots of color variety, repeat bloomer

FL: Floribunda      A bouquet on every branch

GR: Grandiflora      Large blooms, long stems, nice cut flowers
