Citrus cool season fertilizer bag contents/instructions:

0 10 10
N P K + IRON

Nitrogen=0

Phosphorous=10 Bone Meal

Potash (Potassium)=10 Kelp Meal

+IRON

Equal parts of each; use once a year; sprinkle 6 inches from trunk & out to 1/14 drip line No

Clumping
