<b>Garlic, <i>Allium Sativum</i></b>	Harvest green garlic.				Harvest bulbs.					Plant cloves.		
<b>Shallots, <i>A. cepa var. aggregatum</i></b>					Harvest bulbs.					Plant individual sets.		
<b>Leeks, <i>Allium ampeloprasum</i> or <i>A. porrum</i></b>												
Spring-planted leeks	Start seeds in pots.		Set out seedlings into beds.			Harvest leeks as they size up.						
Fall planted leeks			Harvest.				Start seeds in pots.		Transplant to beds.			
<b>Green onions, <i>Allium cepa</i></b>												
Green onions from seed	Start seeds anytime, set out into beds after about 8 weeks, harvest as needed. Sow several times per year, in different seasons.											
Green onions from sets or starts	Plant whenever available, harvest as needed.											
<b>Perennial green onions, <i>Allium fistulosum</i></b>												
From seed	Start seeds indoors.		Set out plants. Harvest green tops as needed. Go dormant in cold weather, resprout early spring.									
From divisions	Divide in early spring, as growth gets started. Harvest as needed. Dormant in coldest weather.											
<b>Chives, <i>Allium schoenoprasum</i></b>												
From seed	Start seeds indoors.		Set out plants. Harvest green tops as needed. Go dormant in cold weather, resprout early spring.									
From divisions	Set out clumps anytime. Harvest green tops as needed. Go dormant in coldest weather.
