	<p>Acer palmatum spp., Japanese Maple</p>	<p>Small trees, various sizes. Japanese maples are beautiful specimen trees given the right conditions. In our area plant them in partial shade in good soil that is slightly acidic (6 to 7). Fairly disease and insect free.</p>
	<p>Achillea millifolium, Yarrow, various colors</p>	<p>1-3' perennial ground cover with ferny leaves. Tough plant, spreads quickly by rhizomes under optimum conditions. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant. Full sun.</p>
	<p>Aeonium haworthii, Haworth's aeonium, Pinwheel Aeonium</p>	<p>6-12" beautiful succulent with up to 4" thick fleshy leaves green rimmed with red. Easy to grow in a pot in loose, porous soil. They need 6 hours of sun/day. In the ground plant in well-drained soil. Rock gardens are perfect. Blooms in spring.</p>
	<p>Aloe Vera</p>	<p>1-2' perennial succulent. Easy to grow, likes dry conditions, well-drained soil. Has been used topically for skin problems. Deer resistant. Do not let your cat or dog eat this plant. Can be a house plant. Full sun.</p>
	<p>Alstroemeria aurantiaca, Peruvian Lily</p>	<p>12-18" beautiful pink-flowered perennial. Full sun but likes afternoon shade. Gorgeous cut flowers. Pollinator plant. Likes well-drained soil.</p>
	<p>Aquilegia chrysantha, Golden Columbine</p>	<p>2-3' fabulous vigorous Columbine. Flowers are held erect on long stems. Can take some sun or part shade. Beneficial, deer and rabbit resistant.</p>
	<p>Aquilegia formosa, Western Columbine</p>	<p>2-3' native perennial wildflower with delicate blue-green foliage and hanging yellow and red-spurred flowers. Blooms May through June. Self-seeds. Attracts hummingbirds, bees and butterflies. Deer resistant Sun/part shade.</p>
	<p>Aquilegia caerulea, Columbine, assorted colors</p>	<p>1-2' beautiful, dainty fern-like foliage with spurred, nodding flowers in purples, lavenders and pinks. Reseeds, toxic to people. Drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant. Partial shade.</p>
	<p>Asclepias fascicularis, Narrowleaf Milkweed</p>	<p>4-6' Nevada County native. Sweet-scented flowers with long narrow leaves. Extremely drought tolerant once established. Excellent monarch butterfly host plant. Spreads by underground rhizomes and less so by seed. Full Sun.</p>

	Asclepias speciosa, Showy Milkweed	1.5-3' Nevada County native. Sweet scented flowers, with large leaves. Extremely drought tolerant once established. Excellent Monarch Butterfly host plant. Spreads vigorously by underground rhizomes and less so by seed. Plant where it can spread. Pollinator magnet. Full Sun.
	Aster novi-belgii, New York Aster	3-6' floriferous perennial aster. Beautiful small violet/purple daisy flowers cover the stems in late summer and fall. Prune asters back in early summer to about 18". This is a tough plant that will spread. Cut down to ground in winter. Pollinators love this plant! Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Berkheya purpurea 'Zulu Warrior'	3' flower stalks. New to MGs, this deciduous perennial forms pale lilac flowers in summer, foliage is grey green. Deer resistant and drought tolerant. Full sun.
	Buddleja x weyeriana, Honeycomb Butterfly Bush	12' easy to grow perennial deciduous shrub. Long lasting creamy yellow flowers with orange centers. Flowers from June to Sept. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Calycanthus florides, Sweetshrub	6-12' tall native deciduous shrub with showy fragrant dark red blooms. Butterflies and pollinators. Deer resistant, resistant to fire in the landscape. Full sun/partial shade.
	Campanula takesimana, Korean Bellflower	18-30" Fast growing mounding perennial with upright stems with lilac pink drooping bells. Vigorous. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun/Partial shade.
	Care testacea, New Zealand Sage, Orange	18-24" Mounding sedge with bronze green leaves that change to electric orange in the fall. Needs regular water. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun/Partial Shade.
	Centaurea americana, Basket Flower (purple)	1.5-5' native annual with 4-5" cream-colored center with bright purple edged flowers. They close at night. Drought tolerant. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Ceratostigma plumbaginoides, Dwarf Plumbago	9-12" fabulous ground cover, All Star, beautiful electric blue flowers with bronze-green foliage on wiry stems that turns bronzy red in the fall. Tough deer resistant, drought tolerant (needs good drainage) ground cover. A winner! Full sun.
	Cercis occidentalis, Western Redbud	12-15' deciduous native shrub or multi-branched tree. Beautiful spring color from rosy-lavender buds. Romantic heart-shaped leaves start apple-green, turn blue-green as they age. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant. Full sun/partial shade.

	Chamaemelum nobile, Roman Chamomile	4-8" perennial ground cover/lawn substitute. Small white daisy flowers with yellow eyes. Deer resistant. Full Sun.
	Clematis virginiana, Virgin's Bower, Woodbine	Up to 20' long USA native climbing vine. A rapid grower with small lovely clusters of flowers. Give it support and cut back in late fall/early spring. Spreads rapidly. Deer resistant. Full sun/partial shade (will flower in shade).
	Coreopsis hybrida 'Incredible', Tickseed	36-48" hardy annual mix of daisy-like flowers in new exciting colors from ruby, buttercream white and rose with contrasting dark centers. Easy to grow, heat tolerant. Beneficials love this plant. Harvest when 1/3 of flowers on stem are open. Reseeds happily. Full sun.
	Coreopsis tinctoria, Dyer's Coreopsis, Tickseed	32-48" beautiful solid and bi-colored flowers in red/yellow, crimson and yellow speckled. Great filler plant. Harvest frequently for more flower production. Reseeds happily. Used for rust and mahogany dyes. Full sun.
	Cornus sericea, Red Twig Dogwood	A deciduous native, a loose-branching shrub growing 6-12' tall with smooth dark red, shiny bark. Creamy-white flowers in late spring with clusters of small white berries in summer. Especially valued for their bright red stems and branches. Plant in part shade to full sun in moist, well-draining soil.
	Cosmos bipinnatus 'Velouette'	36-42" Eye-catching stripes, easy as pie culture, and loads of blossoms make this an essential border flower. Not fussy about soil, just deadhead or cut for bouquets to keep the show going. Pollinator friendly. Full Sun.
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Cupcake Blush'	40-48" Sugarplum fairy flowers. Pale-blush petals form teacup. Large blooms. A favorite of MGs. Harvest when flowers are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Beneficials galore. Full sun.
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Double Click Bicolor Violet'	24-40" double & semi-double blooms, deep violet, purple & white. Stunning blooms. Shorter than the Cupcake series. Harvest when buds are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Beneficials galore. Full sun.

	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Double Click Cranberries'	36-42" double full blooms. Colors range from white, cranberry, mauve and blush. Shorter than the Cupcake series. Harvest when buds are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Beneficials galore. Full sun. NEW!
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Psyche White'	24" single perfect white blooms with yellow centers. Lovely cottage garden look. Butterflies and pollinators love this cosmos. Harvest when buds are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Full sun.
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Rose Bonbon'	36-42" double and triple pink blooms. We love this cosmos. Shorter than the Cupcake series. Harvest when buds are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Beneficials galore. Full sun.
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Rosetta'	30-36" pink pastel lightly striped petals. Harvest when buds are just beginning to open to stop pollination from occurring. Beneficials galore. Full sun.
	Cosmos bipinnatus, 'Sensation Radiance'	48-60" Everyone's favorite summer flower, this cosmos provides nonstop flowers. Beautiful purple/pink with dark eyes. Provide support when young and cut often for armloads of flowers. Full sun.
	Cotinus coggygria, Smoke Bush	20' deciduous shrub valued for its vivid foliage, autumnal purple hue and clusters of flowers that resemble plumes of smoke. Prefers well-draining soil. Plant in full sun. Drought tolerant once established
	Cynoglossum amabile, 'Mystic Pink'	30" Chinese Forget-Me-Nots that produce flowers in three months on tall stems with delicate pretty pink flowers. Fabulous filler in bouquets. Prone to wilting in the heat, so harvest in early morning or evening and plunge in water immediately for a couple of hours. Full sun.
	Dahlia pinnata, Double Decorative Blend	4-5' Dahlia with 3" single and fully-double flowers in a variety of colors. Back of the border. Grown from seed, produces tubers in fall. Stake at planting time so stems don't break. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open. Full Sun.
	Dahlia spp.	Mystery colored dahlias, 2-year-old tubers, single and double flowered. Colors range from pink, purple, yellow and more. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open Full sun.


	Dahlia Variabilis, Mignon Rose	18-20" Lovely bedding dahlia with deep pink flowers with yellow centers. Blooms until frost. Grown from seed will produce tubers in the fall. Full Sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'American Dawn'	24-36" decorative dahlia with coral petals and a violet purple center streaked with plum. Great cut flower. Blooms mid summer to frost Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open Full sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida spp.	4-5' Single purple/pink dahlia. Very prolific. 4" blossoms. Blooms mid summer to frost. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open. Full sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Akita'	36-48' dinner plate dahlia with cinnabar red and ivory petals with a yellow center. Great cut flower. Blooms mid summer until frost. Minimum 6 hours of sun per day. Full Sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Alauna Clair-Obscur'	36-48' fimbriated cactus dahlia with two-tone flower of burgundy in the center and violet and white on the tips. Great cut flower. Blooms mid summer until frost. Minimum 6 hours of sun per day. Full Sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Boom Boom Yellow'	36-40" wonderful small yellow ball dahlia. Long stems for a workhorse cut flower. Foliage dark green and glossy. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open. Full sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Cafe au Lait'	36-48" dinner plate dahlia. Cream and pale pink flowers with blossoms that are 8-10". Excellent cut flowers. Blooms summer until frost. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open. Full sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Dreamcatcher'	4' semi-cactus dahlia with 6" rose peach and soft yellow petals. Excellent cut flower. Stake at planting time so stems don't break. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open Full sun.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Gabrielle Marie'	4' Informal decorative dahlia with 5" blooms. Peach and golden tones with a hint of lavender blush. Excellent cut flower. Six hours minimum of sun per day.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Ivanetti'	4' deep maroon ball dahlia with 4" blooms. Great cut flower. Blooms mid summer until frost. Six hours minimum of sun per day.
	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Jowey Winnie'	36-48" dramatic gorgeous peachy to lavender center ball dahlia. Long stems for a workhorse cut flower that just keeps on going all summer into fall. Stake at planting time so stems don't break Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open.

	Dahlia x hybrida, 'Vancouver'	34-36" purple dinner plate with white edging, beautiful spider look. 6-8" blossoms. Blooms mid summer to frost. Pinch center stem at 12" tall. Cut when flowers are open or almost open Full sun.
	Delphinium elatum, Pacific Giant Astolat	4-7' fabulous perennial with amazing colors. Very hardy, needs some afternoon shade in hot areas. Deer resistant.
	Delphinium elatum, Pacific Giant King Arthur	4-7' fabulous perennial with amazing dark blue spires. Very hardy, Full sun but needs some afternoon shade in hot areas. Deer resistant.
	Delphinium elatum, Pacific Giant, dark blue	4-7' fabulous perennial with amazing colors. Very hardy, needs some afternoon shade in hot areas. Deer resistant.
	Echinops bannaticus, Glue Glow Globe Thistle	3-4' herbacious perennial with electric blue round flowers. Blooms early to late summer. Great cut flower, excellent fresh or dry. Pollinator plant. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full Sun.
	Erigeron karvinskianus, Fleabane, Santa Barbara Daisy	1-2' Trailing ground cover with small white and pink daisies. Flowers almost year around. Good trailer over wall or in pots. Deer resistant. Full Sun but could use afternoon shade. Drought tolerant. Pollinator plant.
	Eryngium planum 'Blue Glitter', Sea Holy	36-40" Clear blue small Spherical flower heads. Great cut flowers both fresh or dried. Grows. Pollinator plant. Drought tolerant. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full Sun.
	Forsythia x intermedia, Golden Bell	6-8' deciduous shrub makes an excellent formal hedge. Prized for its bright yellow flower in early spring. Needs good drainage. Full Sun.
	Gaura lindheimeri, Wand Flower	2-3' Deciduous shrub with loose sprays of pink flowers. Great filler plant. Xeriscape. Drought tolerant once established. Full sun.
	Geranium sanguineum spp., Bloody Cranesbill	18" wonderful easy ground cover with magenta flowers. This variety has larger finely cut leaves and flowers than the traditional geranium sanguineum. Full Sun/Part Shade. Deer and Rabbit Resistant.
	Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'	12-18" fabulous variegated grass that thrives in the shade, tough as nails, beautiful and easy to grow. Takes partial shade. Provide summer water. Deer resistant and can be planted near black walnut trees. A winner!

	Heliopsis helianthoides, Heliopsis Burning Hearts	3-4' bushy, strong upright perennial plant with dark purple foliage and contrasting gold and red-orange petals. Drought resistant. Pollinator plant. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun.
	Helipterum roseum, Strawflower 'Pierrot White'	18" The papery white blooms excel in fresh-cut or dried arrangements. Drought tolerant. Well-drained soil. Pick when just starting to open. Hang to dry. Pollinator plant. Full sun.
	Helleborus orientalis, Lenten Rose	12-18" early blooming fabulous, easy to care for tough perennial for shade/part shade. Deer resistant. Pollinator plant. Nice cut flowers.
	Hemerocallis spp., Daylily	12-18" double orange daylily. Tough, easy-to-grow perennial, drought tolerant, heat tolerant. Good border plant. Needs 6 hours of sun.
	Holodiscus discolor, Oceanspray, Cream Bush	10-15' broadleaf deciduous native shrub. It has lovely white to cream drooping flower clusters. Almost maintenance free. Moderate deer resistance and is drought tolerant. Full sun.
	Hydrangea quercifolia, Oakleaf Hydrangea	6-8' beautiful deciduous flowering shrub with 3 seasons of interest. In spring gorgeous, long-lasting large clusters of flowers begin white and slowly change to creamy pink. Fall color has large leaves turning orange, bronze or red. As with all hydrangeas the plants are toxic to humans, dogs and cats. Part shade/full sun.
	Kalanchoe daigremontiana, Mother of thousands, Alligator plant	1-3' succulent houseplant or in pots that can be protected in winter. Very cool plant with new baby plants growing along the edge of the leaves. Low maintenance as a houseplant, drought tolerant, heat tolerant. Needs some sun.
	Lagurus ovatus, Bunnytail, Hare's-Tail	12" upright clump grass with showy creamy bunny-tail-shaped plumes. Easy to grow, drought tolerant, deer resistant. Full sun.
	Leucanthemum x superbum, Shasta Daisy	2-3' white-flowered Shasta Daisy. Easy to grow. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, good cut flower.

	Leucanthemum x superbum spp., Dwarf Shasta Daisy	1.5' white-flowered Shasta Daisy. Compact and spreads slowly to a nicely formed clump. Easy, deer resistant and drought tolerant. Full sun.
	Lychnis coronaria, Rose Campion	2' clump forming perennial with silver-gray, soft wooly foliage and dark rose-magenta flowers. Very tough plant that tolerates drought and is deer resistant. Full sun.
	Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light'	4-6' fabulous variegated grass, easy to grow. This is a specimen grass that has a vase shape and has wonderful winter color. Drought tolerant, deer and rabbit resistant, usually disease and pest free. Full sun.
	Monarda didyma, Scarlet Beebalm	2-3' perennial herb with showy scarlet flower clusters. As its name implies, the bees love these flowers as well as hummingbirds and butterflies. Full sun. Will reseed so take off flower heads after bloom if you don't want it to spread. Full sun/dappled shade (fewer flowers). Deer resistant.
	Pelargonium capitatum 'Attar of Roses', Geranium	1-2' half-hardy rose-scented geranium is a wonderful plant that can be grown indoors or outside with some winter protection. The rose scent is amazing in bouquets and the oil is used as an ingredient in perfumes, liqueurs, potpourris and other products. Drought tolerant. Full sun with afternoon shade.
	Peonia officinalis, Peony	Herbaceous perennial that is easy to grow. Fabulous spring flowers. Needs composted, well draining soil. Support flowers with cages. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun
	Phlox paniculata, Garden Phlox	3-4' dark pink/purple flower clusters. Long bloom season, spreads underground, full sun. Forms a beautiful large clump with time.
	Prunus cerasifera, Ornamental Plum	25' drought tolerant deciduous tree with gorgeous pink-purple spring flowers with bronze, red and purple leaves. Keep away from walkway where fruit drop is a nuisance. Full sun/ part shade.

	Romneya coulteri, Matilija Poppy	4-5' California native. Petals have a wrinkly, delicate texture, but can withstand strong winds and rain. Spectacular flowers produce abundant nectar and attract many pollinators. Drought tolerant once established. Dormant in winter. Spreads by rhizomes. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun.
	Rudbeckia hirta, Black-eyed Susan, autumn colors	24-30" biennial/short-lived perennial. Easy to grow, deer resistant, drought tolerant once established. Pollinator plant. Reseeds. Full sun.
	Salvia guaranitica, Black & Blue Salvia	3-4' cobalt blue to black tubular blooms. Lush green foliage. Blooms late spring to fall. Pollinator plant. Somewhat deer resistant. Full Sun.
	Salvia spathacea, Hummingbird Sage	1-3' native perennial ground cover/low shrub for dry shade! Will grow under oaks. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant once established. Dry shade.
	Salvia transsylvanica, Blue Cloud Transylvania sage	3' Hardy perennial with beautiful spikes of sky-blue flowers from June to Sept. Excellent for cutting. Pollinator plant. Drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Salvia x superba, Salvia Violet Queen	2' perennial with violet-purple flower spires. Pollinator. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant. Full sun.
	Salvia yangii, Russian Sage, syn. Perovskia atriplicifolia	3-5' Member of the mint family. Silvery Grey Fragrant foliage with lavender flowers with a long bloom period. May need to be staked. xeriscaping. Pollinator plant. Heat tolerant. Deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun.
	Scabiosa atropurpurea 'Black Knight', Pincushion Flower	36-48" pincushion flower, hardy annual. Very dark burgundy flower head with white stigmas. 1st place winner at Nevada County Fair, deer resistant, pollinator plant. MG favorite. Harvest in bud stage or when just opening. Full sun.
	Scabiosa caucasica 'Fama Blue', Pincushion Flower	18-24" easy reliable flower with huge rich lavender, violet scented blooms to 4" across are studded with white pins atop sturdy stems to 3' tall. Excellent for cutting. Blooms late spring to fall with deadheading. Cut to 2" tall in the winter. Great pollinator plant. Sun/part shade.

	Scabiosa columbaria, Purple, Pincushion Flower	12-18" Herbaceous perennial with purple pincushion flowers. Pollinator. Drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Sedum rupestre, Sedum 'Angelina'	4-6" wonderful lime-green/yellow succulent-like foliage with bright yellow star-like flowers in summer. Foliage turns golden orange in the fall. Full sun/part shade. Low nutrients.
	Sedum spectabile 'Autumn Joy', Autumn Stonecrop	1-2' dependable, classy perennial that won't disappoint. Flower heads are a deep pink atop grey-green succulent-like foliage. Drought tolerant, deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun is best.
	Sedum reflexum, Blue Spruce Creeping Sedum	5" low-growing, mat-forming blue-green leaved succulent. Has yellow flowers in summer. Easy to grow, spreads rapidly. Super hardy, drought tolerant, deer and rabbit resistant. Full sun.
	Silene pendula, 'Sibella Carmine'	6-12" hardy annual. Flowers spring to summer. Beautiful plant for pots or borders. Covered with tiny rose colored flowers. Full sun/part shade.
	Silene vulgaris 'Blushing Lanterns'	18-30" perennial with grey-green stems covered with pale green blush pods and white petals. Great filler plant for bouquets and arrangements. Full sun.
	Spiraea prunifolia, Bridal Wreath	4-8' medium-sized deciduous shrub. Produces a cascading waterfall of small white clusters of flowers that bloom all the way down the arching branches. Drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Stachys byzantina 'Helene Von Stein', Lamb's Ear	Great variety of Lamb's Ear, very large-leaved ground cover, leaves are fuzzy, soft and silver. Great dry area ground cover. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, black walnut tolerant. Purple flowers in the summer. Full sun.
	Syringa vulgaris v. alba, Lilac White	12-15' Deciduous perennial multi-stemmed shrub with fragrant white flowers. Pollinator plant. Good cut flower. Deer resistant. Full sun.

	Syringa vulgaris, Lilac Purple	12-15' Deciduous perennial multi-stemmed shrub with fragrant purple flowers. Pollinator plant. Good cut flower. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	Tanacetum coccineum, Robinson's Painted Daisy	2-3' perennial that produces 2-3" daisy-like flowers in shade of pink and red. Pest and disease resistant. Pollinator. Deer resistant. Full sun, may need afternoon shade.
	Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Mariesii', Doublefile Viburnum	6-8' specimen deciduous shrub with horizontal branches covered with lacecap white flowers followed by berries in the fall. Can spread to 10' wide. Deer resistant. Leaves turn red in the fall. Full sun/part shade.
	Zauschneria californica, syn. Epilobium canum, California Fuchsia	15-30" Native perennial small shrub for native dry gardens and hillsides. Requires no summer water once established. Late summer and fall blooms with scarlet red trumpet flowers. Silvery-green foliage. Drought tolerant and deer resistant. Full sun.
	Zinnia elegans 'Benary's Giant Golden Yellow'	36-48" deep golden yellow huge mostly double blooms on strong stems. One of the best zinnias you can grow. Great disease resistance. Harvest by gently shaking stem 8" below flower. Stem needs to be stiff or not ready. Full sun.
	Zinnia elegans 'Oklahoma Carmine'	30-40" rose magenta blooms on tough strong stems. Vigorous plants. As with all zinnias, the more you cut, the more they come again. Harvest by gently shaking stem 8" below flower. Stem needs to be stiff or not ready. Full sun.
	Zinnia elegans 'Oklahoma Salmon'	30-40" soft salmon blooms on tough strong stems. Vigorous plants. As with all zinnias, the more you cut, the more they come again. Harvest by gently shaking stem 8" below flower. Stem needs to be stiff or not ready. Full sun.
	Zinnia elegans 'Benary's Giant Carmine Rose'	36-48" crimson rose huge mostly double blooms on strong stems. One of the best zinnias you can grow. Great disease resistance. Harvest by gently shaking stem 8" below flower. Stem needs to be stiff or not ready. Full sun. NEW!
	Zinnia elegans 'Benary's Giant Deep Red'	36-48" ruby-red huge mostly double blooms on strong stems. One of the best zinnias you can grow. Great disease resistance. Harvest by gently shaking stem 8" below flower. Stem needs to be stiff or not ready. Full sun.
